Per Title 8 of the United States Code of Federal Regulations 214.3 (k) (2), Towson is required to verify the financial support of an admitted student before issuing an I-20/DS-2019 document (also known as the Certificate of Eligibility).

- Admitted students must demonstrate that they have access to funds to cover their first year of study or the length of their program, whichever is shorter.
- Financial document requirements:
  - 1. Must be dated within the past 3 months and be in English
  - 2. Must indicate the currency of the account
  - 3. Must be liquid funds (i.e. no unsecured loans, stocks, property, or statements of annual salary): all monies must be accessible at the time of submission
  - 4. Must be on the financial organization's letterhead
  - 5. Must have the account holder's name listed. If using a company account, we require evidence that the sponsor owns the company and has access to the company account funds.

- The student and financial sponsor should keep a copy of this form for their records.
