## Using the Crestron Audio-Visual Control System

If touch screen is blank, touch center of screen to wake from Sleep Mode.

Press "Start" to begin using the audio/visual system.

- Computer will display the PC in the podium.
- **Laptop** allows you to connect a laptop computer in the Auxiliary box located on top of the podium.

- **DVD-VCR Combo** Press "**Controls**" to display player controls for DVD or VCR.
