New Scholarship!

We are excited to announce the new Tobey Hillel Roland Family Endowed Scholarship in Spanish! This scholarship is for graduate students with a 3.5 GPA who have demonstrated financial need. In order to show financial need, applicants must complete the FAFSA for this academic year

The application is open from **September 17th–October 31st**. Applicants will need to submit a 250–500 word essay in Spanish highlighting their achievements, community service, and/or passions beyond the scope of academic work. They must also submit an unofficial transcript and a letter of recommendation from a faculty member. Results will be announced November 21st.
