✓ Qualifications for membership

- Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate student at the sophomore level or higher.
 - Graduate in Fall 2023 or later.
 - Have completed at least two semesters of college Spanish at the 300-400 level, and at least one 3-credit course in literature or civilization/culture. Those currently enrolled in such a course may be eligible if their projected grade is a "B" or better.
 - Have attained a "B" average in all of their Spanish courses.
 - Have an overall GPA of 2.75.
 - Show interest in things Hispanic and be of good moral character.
 - Submit an application form accompanied by a \$50 one time membership fee.
