If you answered yes to any of the above questions, you should consider applying for a position as a research assistant in Dr. Buckingham's social psychology lab.

Current research projects are related to the following topics:

- The effect of threats to the self on contingencies of self-worth and behavior.
- The effect of focusing on a future self on evaluations of the current self.

The research assistant positions are not paid, but you can earn course credit for your work by signing up for Directed Research in Psychology (3 credit course). Hours are fairly flexible, but you need to be able to commit to 5 hours per week.

Preferred Qualifications: Taken or taking Psyc 314 (Research Methods) and Psyc 325 (Social Psych), Cumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher, available for 2 semesters.
