Proficiency Levels for Applied Lessons

Discipline: PERCUSSION

General Information:

- The stated proficiencies below apply to all students taking lessons in the particular discipline.
- Level of difficulty for specific repertoire will be adjusted based upon the student's degree program.
- These proficiencies are the minimums for a passing grade in the discipline.
- Any student wishing to take 300-level applied lessons must successfully pass an upper division jury demonstrating the proficiencies as articulated below.

Proficiencies for a 1-credit lesson

<u>Freshman Level</u>

- Working concept of tone production
- Understanding of grip and techniques
- Kraus scale forms in major keys
- > Rhythmic and melodic reading and improvisation
- > Mastery of repertoire for snare drum and 2-mallet keyboard

Sophomore Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- Advanced concept of tone production
- ➤ Mastery of 13 Essential Rudiments
- Kraus scale forms in minor keys
- > All major and minor scales/arpeggios

- > Mastery of repertoire for snare drum and keyboard
- > Timpani tuning, tone production and lift strokes

Upper Division Jury (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

> Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years

Junior Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- ➤ 4-mallet exercises and repertoire
- ➤ Timpani repertoire

Senior Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- Vibraphone and Multi-percussion repertoire
- Accessory percussion
- > Senior Recital (required based upon degree program)

Proficiencies for a 2-credit lesson

Freshman Level

- Working concept of tone production
- Understanding of grip and techniques
- > Kraus scale forms in major and minor keys
- > Rhythmic and melodic reading and improvisation
- > Mastery of repertoire for snare drum and 2-mallet keyboard
- Timpani tuning, tone production and lift strokes

Sophomore Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- Advanced concept of tone production

- > Mastery of 40 PAS Rudiments
- > All major and minor scales/arpeggios
- ➤ 4-mallet exercises and repertoire
- > Mastery of repertoire for snare drum, keyboard and timpani

<u>Upper Division Jury</u> (end of 2nd semester sophomore lessons)

> Proficiency in all material assigned in the first two years.

Junior Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- > Timpani, vibraphone and multi-percussion repertoire
- > Accessory percussion
- > Junior recital (required based on degree program)

Senior Level

- > Above proficiencies plus:
- > Orchestral excerpts
- > Senior recital (required based upon degree program)
