

# Sustainable Transportation, Tiger Go Green, & Carpool - Students

Effective July 1, 2024, Sustainable Transportation Program, Carpool, and Tiger Go Green participants will begin using a new online reservation system for parking called "Off-Street."


- **Sustainable Transportation** and **Carpool** participants will be issued 8 codes annually (4 per term), and codes are valid until the end of August each year.
- **Tiger Go Green** approved permit holders will be issued only 4 codes annually (2 per term), and codes are valid until the end of August each year.

#### Information for your guest regarding the Off-Street permit:

- Go to the web link below based on your approved program to obtain your permit. (You cannot access through the ParkMobile app) Please note: You do not have to create an account to process and/or obtain a permit, but an access code will be required.

- You will use your TU ID# as your "Access Code" and will need to provide an email to send your permit
  confirmation.

### Here are the instructions to reserve/obtain parking for your guest through Off-street:

- 1. Click or type in the applicable program permit link above.
- 2. Follow the prompts for permit information.
- 4. Enter your License Plate Number and State, click "Next"
- 5. Enter Access Code which is your TU ID#, click "Next"
- 6. Select the Date that permit will need to park your vehicle on campus, then click Park.
- 7. Email address is optional but encouraged for you to receive a confirmation email and reminder email 24 hours prior to arrival to campus.



#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Where is my permit valid?

• Your parking permit, through Off-Street, in any **visito**r space, including those restricted to visitors with a "Code," in the Union, Glen, Towsontown and West Village Garages. It Is also valid in overflow spaces at the Stadium Lots, (Lots 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8) where the black bordered signs read: **"All TU Permits Valid."** 



## Where can I park If I have an accessibility (handicap) plate/placard?

• You may park in any accessible parking space on campus. Please consult a campus map (www.towson.edu/maps)

## What if I bring a vehicle that was not registered through Off-Street?

• If you have to bring another vehicle to campus instead of the one that you registered through Off-Street, contact the Parking & Transportation Services Office at <a href="mailto:upark@towson.edu">upark@towson.edu</a> to cancel the previous reservation. Do not attempt to park a car on campus that is not registered. This could result in a citation.
