Incident Summary:

On **Friday**, **Aug. 28**, **2020** at approximately **4:15 p.m.**, the Towson University Police Department became aware of an **ON CAMPUS 4th Degree SEXUAL ASSAULT (Fondling)** occurring at the **Tubman House**.

Beginning at approximately 8:45 p.m. on Aug. 27 through 3 a.m. on Aug. 28, the suspect inappropriately touched the victim.

The suspect has been identified as Kenneth Tang Kum

Description: Male, black, 6 feet tall, weighing 245 pounds, dark complexion, close cropped black hair, slight mustache.

Suspect is operating a four-door, grey Nissan Altima, Maryland Registration 5EF3367. Vehicle was last seen parked inside of the West Village Garage.

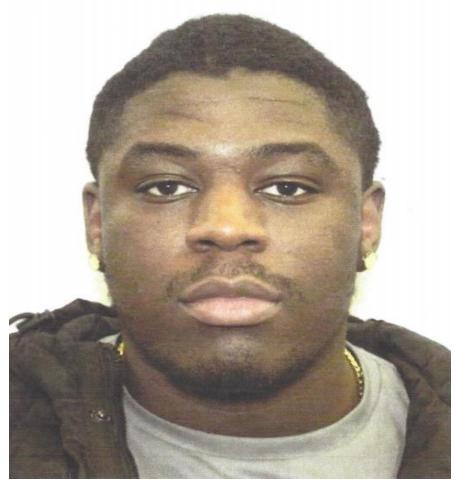

TU EMERGENCY ALERT: ARMED ROBBERY

Incident Summary:

On **Saturday, April 25, 2020** at approximately **3:45 am**, the Towson University Police Department became aware of an **ON CAMPUS ARMED ROBBERY** at the **Center for the Arts parking lot #12**.

The victim reported having been robbed on 04/24/20 at 11:45pm. Three males exited a vehicle after driving onto the parking lot and robbed the victim, who was inside a parked vehicle, of personal property. Two of the three subjects were armed with handguns. The subjects then drove off, exiting the parking lot onto Osler Drive.
